## FOR ATTENTION OF THE CANDIDATES :

The applicants before applying the **B.Ed-Spl.Ed(ID)** course are advised to go through the prospectus, to know about the profile of the Training Institution. They are also advised to visit the Institute Campus at- Jyoti Nagar, Gobindpur, Dist.-Dhenkanal. If they so desire and see for themselves the available infrastructure and other facilities. If satisfied, they may apply for the course as per their eligibility. Once admitted, making any Unreasonable demand there after shall not be entertained and it shall be treated as an act of indiscipline.

### 1. Introduction :

**Jibanjyoti College of Special Education (JCSE), Jyoti Nagar, Gobindpur, Dist.-Dhenkanal**, has been established since 2018 by Jibanjyoti Welfare Association for Mentally and Physically Handicapped , a state level leading organization registered under Society Registration Act XXI of 1860, No.21248/52 of 2001-2002, dt- 14.05.2001 issued against old registration no. 20439/203 of 1997-98. The main objective of JJCS is to undertake man power development and provide services in Persons with Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities and Cerebral palsy. As the part of the Training Programmes, **JCSE** offers Two academic years Diploma level Teachers Training Courses such as **D.Ed- Spl.Ed(IDD) & B.Ed.Spl.Ed(ID)** approved by Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi, recognized by govt. of Odisha, Department of Social Security and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities & affiliated to Utkal University,Bhubaneswar.

### 2. Course Objectives :

The B.Ed-Special Education Programme aims to develop Special Education Teachers/Educators for Children with disabilities for various settings (including Inclusive, Special, Open School and Home Based Education). The B.Ed.(Special Education) programme will prepare human resources to enable them to acquire knowledge and develop competencies and skills to impart education and training effectively to children with disability as well as all other children. After completing the B.Ed(Special Education) programme, the student-teachers will :

- a. Acquire Knowledge & skills about human development, contemporary Indian education; pedagogy of various school subjects and assessment of learning.
- b. Acquire knowledge & skills about nature and educational needs of Children with Disabilities as well as a few selected specific disabilities.
- c. Develop Conceptual understanding of educational provisions and skills for working for children with various disabilities in Special and Inclusive Education settings.
- d. Enhance knowledge and skills for professional development.

### 3. Nomenclature:

Nomenclature of B.Ed Special Education Programme would be as per UGC Notification of 2009/2014 and new nomenclature will be **B.Ed.Spl.Ed(ID)**.

#### 4. Placement opportunities to work as Special Educator:

- a. In regular (Inclusive) Schools.
- b. Special Schools.
- c. In research projects on Special Education.
- d. Coordinator of Anganwadi Centres, and any Govt./private pre-school canters for children with Special Educational needs.
- e. To be an Itinerant Teacher for school children with Intellectual Disabilities.
- f. Home Based Education.

5. **Eligibility:** The candidates securing at least 50% of marks in general category or 45% of marks in SC/ST/OBC/SEBC/PH category in Graduation (B.A/B.Sc or an equivalent) examination approved by the Utkal University with school subjects for pedagogical courses will eligible to apply. The appearing candidates at final year Graduation (B.A/B.Sc or equivalent) examination may also apply, provided they obtain minimum percent of marks in Graduation examination during the time of their admission failing which their claim for admission shall be cancelled.

6. **Selection:** The Merit List will be prepared on the basis of Career and Entrance Test marks. The Career mark is calculated on the basis of 25% of H.S.C/equivalent Examination, 25% of 10+2/equivalent Examination, 25% of Graduation (+3) level marks and 25% of marks are calculated from Entrance Test.

#### 7. Entrance Test :

The test will have 50 objective/multiple choice questions which will have four alternative answers. There is no negative marking for incorrect/wrong answer. The test has been designed on the following description.

SEAT:

There shall be 30 seats available for the course with reservation as per the Govt. rules.

### 11. Reservation of seats:

There shall be 16% of seats (5 seats) reserved for SC, 23% of seats (7 seats) for ST, 11% of seats (3 seats) for SEBC/OBC. 4 % of total nos. of seat (1 seat) will be reserved for Orthopedically Handicapped (OH with mild disability in one lower/ upper limb only) candidates. In case of non-availability of candidates in any of these categories, seats shall be filled up from the candidates of the general category. 50% of seats will be reserved for women candidates (15 seats)

### 12. Caste Certificate:

In case of SC, ST and OBC/SEBC candidates, the caste certificate should have been issued by the concerned Tahasildar/ Additional Tahasildar of the locality of candidates. The Caste Certificate shall be considered by virtue of birth only not by marriage or adoption.

### 13. Disability Certificate :

The candidates are required to submit PWD Certificate issued in their favour by the concerned Medical Board and counter signed by the CDMO.

### 14. Course Duration:

The duration of the course is two years which can be completed in a minimum of three years from the date of admission as per RCI syllabus. The syllabus can be downloaded from the website of Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) i.e [www.rehabcouncil.nic.in](http://www.rehabcouncil.nic.in) .

### 15. ATTENDANCE :

Students are expected to be regular and punctual. In case the attendance of the student falls below 80% percentage as required by the concerned University/ RCI guidelines, the student may not be allowed to appear for the annual examinations.

### 16. Content of the Course :

**24. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:**

Medium of instruction and Examination will be conducted in English.

**25. IDENTITY CARD :**

Each admitted candidates will be issued with an identity card by the institute. The actual cost of the Identity card will be borne by the students. The candidates shall have to produce the card at various academic programmes and examination centres. The candidates are required to preserve the identity card carefully. This will prove their identity on any matter connected with the institute. In case of loss of the card, a duplicate can be issued on the application along with stamp size photo and payment Rs. 75/- (Rupees Seventy Five only). The identify card is to be surrendered to the institute at the time of taking T.C/CLC & CC.

**26. HOSTEL ACCOMODATION:**

The course involves a lot of practical training during and after the class hours. Hence, it is fully residential course. Hostel accommodation is limited. Hostel will be provided to few candidates on first come first serve basis on request. Boarding charges will have be born by the trainees themselves. The hostellers have to be deposit hostel seat rent and establishment charges (electricity, water, room rent & maintenance service etc.) at the time of admission only. Individual cooking practices are not allowed in the rooms. There are separate fully furnished hostel for the men and women trainees. The trainees remain in the hostel will abide by strict rules and regulations of the Training Centre and infringement of violence thereof shall result in rustication from the hostel for a period as decided by the authority. The trainees are permitted to remain course in the hostel up to summer vacation of the academic session of course completion year or examination whichever is earlier.

**27. ETIQUETTE AND DISCIPLINE:**

a) The candidates must follow the etiquette and discipline within the administrative regulations. They are expected to maintain decorum, decency and discipline throughout the pursuance of the course with the staffs, faculties, co-students and other supporting staffs. Any infringement of the violence shall result in removal from the course.
